

Homework Expectation Sheet Key Stage 1

There is an expectation that children in Key Stage 1 complete at least 1hr of homework each week.

The children will be given a range of homework activities to complete each week:

- A Creative Activity to be completed with a family member.
- A list of between 5-10 spellings. Children will be tested on these spellings each week.
- To read with an adult daily. Children should take home a book each week and parents should complete the child's reading diary and make comments on pupils reading.
- A maths activity

How to support your child with their homework

- Ensure that you embed a consistent time each week in which children can complete their homework.
- Create a relaxed learning environment in which they can concentrate and focus without distraction.
- Provide them with all the equipment they need to be successful
- Offer support and feedback on issues linked to learning e.g. presentation and understanding. Sit down with your child to complete the tasks.
- Praise the children when homework is completed.
- Keep completed homework away from younger siblings to ensure that work does not get damaged.
