

Homework Expectation Sheet Key Stage 2

There is an expectation that children in Key Stage 2 complete at least 1hr 30minutes of homework each week.

The children will be given a range of homework activities to complete each week:

- A Creative Activity (they will be given a list of creative activities to explore at the start of each term) and should choose one activity to complete each week.
- A list of between 10-15 spellings. Children will be tested on these spellings each week.
- A reading activity. In Years 5 and 6 children might be given a comprehension activity. In addition to this they should be reading for enjoyment as regularly as possible. An adult should listen to them read at least twice a week for 30minutes.
- A maths activity
- In Year 5 & 6 children may be given a SPaG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar activity).

How to support your child with their homework

- Ensure that you embed a consistent time each week in which children can complete their homework.
- Create a relaxed learning environment in which they can concentrate and focus without distraction.
- Provide them with all the equipment they need to be successful
- Offer support and feedback on issues linked to learning e.g. presentation and understanding.
- Praise the children when homework is completed.
- Keep completed homework away from younger siblings to ensure that work does not get damaged.
